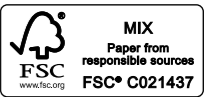

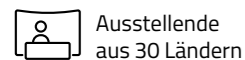

BEHIND GREENHOLDS

90% LESS ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT WITH GREENHOLDS!

BY TIM MULLENS & GEERT VONCKEN

When people hear about Greenholds, they usually say, "That's the company making sustainable climbing holds." And yes, technically, that's true. But what we're really doing is something much larger. We didn't start this company because the world needed more holds. We started it because we couldn't keep pretending our sport, the one so deeply tied to nature, somehow existed outside its impact on the planet.

We've spent a big part of our lives around climbing walls and climbers — that energy, that passion — and yet, behind all that joy, we saw the same problem repeating: waste. Piles of holds discarded each year, made from fossil-based materials, shipped across continents, never recycled. It became impossible to ignore. How did a sport born from rock and earth forget where it came from? That question became our obsession. Greenholds became our answer.

We're based in Sittard, the Netherlands, right next to one of the world's biggest chemical clusters. It sounds like an odd place to start a sustainability revolution, but it's perfect. On the Brightlands Chemelot Campus, we're surrounded by researchers and innovators who are rethinking materials — from bioplastics to circular polymers. We decided to bring that mindset into climbing. What began as an idea sketched on a napkin grew into a

network of companies, engineers, designers, and recyclers, all working together to close the loop.

More than a hundred-forty students have joined us through research projects, exploring, testing, and often challenging our assumptions. Their curiosity keeps us honest. Innovation doesn't come from one genius idea; it comes from a community daring to ask the same uncomfortable question: can we do this better?

CLIMBING WAS BORN FROM ROCK — SO WHEN DID WE FORGET WHERE IT CAME FROM?

Climbing gyms thrive on renewal — new holds, new shapes, constant rotation. But that also means constant waste. Almost every hold made today ends up in landfill or incineration. So we decided to turn that cycle on its head. We produce our holds from 100% recycled nylon waste — not partially recycled, not theoretically recyclable, but truly circular. Every hold can be ground down and reborn as another.

We built a system where at the end of its life, each hold comes back to us. We shred it, melt it, and reuse it. Gyms pay a small

deposit they get back when they return their old holds — a simple gesture that turns sustainability into shared responsibility. It's not symbolic; it's a handshake between us and the community. We call it semi-circular because we're still learning. The world isn't circular yet, but every loop we close gets us closer. To make this possible, we had to work differently — and we had to work together. Collaboration isn't just how we operate; it's the core of everything. The formula, the production, the logistics — they only exist because of the people and companies around us. Instead of guarding secrets, we share what we learn. We believe openness accelerates progress. We don't see competitors; we see potential partners in change.

Our production method is different too: injection moulding instead of casting. It produces zero silicone waste, no excess material, and complete traceability. Every hold is identical, durable, and consistent. They feel a little different — like rock does when you climb outside. It's not a flaw; it's part of the experience. We can't yet make every shape on the market, but what we do make lasts much longer and carries around 90% less environmental impact than traditional PU or PE holds. That number isn't marketing — it's measured, verified, and real.

Gym owners often tell us their climbers notice. They see the difference, they ask about it, and that's where something powerful happens. A conversation starts. Sustainability becomes visible, not abstract. Every route with Greenholds is a small story about responsibility, about doing things differently. People feel proud to climb on them — proud that their gym stands for something. Our journey recently took a wild turn when, together with partners, we managed to turn old climbing ropes into new climbing holds. Actual ropes that once caught falls, now reborn to be grabbed again. Waste from climbers, for climbers. That's the circular economy made tangible — a piece of the sport's own past, reimaged.

We'll be showing these new holds at Vertical PRO 2025. But the real breakthrough isn't the product — it's the process. The realization that none of this works in isolation. Every innovation only matters if it scales, and scaling only happens through collaboration.

IF WE DON'T BUILD TOGETHER, WE'LL BREAK ALONE.

That's why we're building something bigger: the Sustainable Climbing Alliance. A coalition of associations, brands, gyms, universities, and innovators across Europe working toward a truly circular climbing industry. Together we've already submitted an EU proposal to help accelerate this transition. But we're not waiting for funding. We act now, because the urgency doesn't.

We know this path isn't easy. When we started, people said recycled holds would never perform, never look right, never sell. We failed often, learned constantly, and sometimes wondered if the industry even wanted change. But then we'd meet a young setter or gym owner who understood what we were trying to do — and it all made sense again.

We're not just producing holds. We're shaping a mindset. One where climbing contributes to the planet it loves instead of extracting from it. One where collaboration replaces compe-



tion. And one where innovation becomes synonymous with responsibility.

We believe climbing can lead the sports world in sustainability — not follow it. The walls we build are not just for movement, but for momentum. Each new partnership, each returned hold, each curious conversation pushes us forward. That's how transformation begins: quietly, collectively, then all at once.

We're here to climb differently — not just up the wall, but toward a better system. And if we can prove that circularity works in this small, passionate corner of the sports world, maybe we can help others see that change is not only possible — it's already happening.

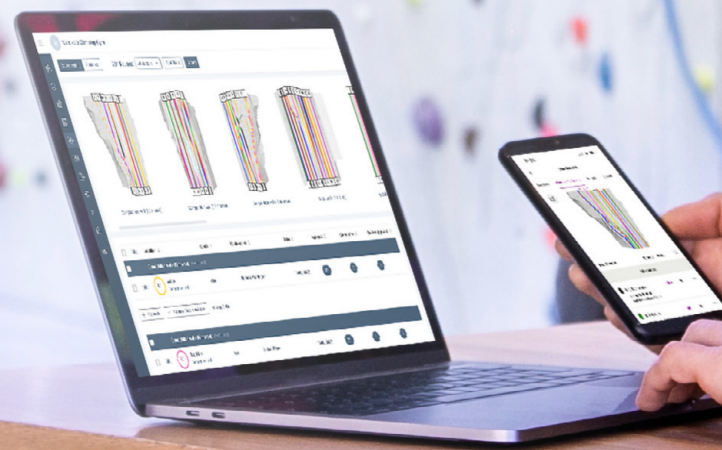
24/7 CLIMBING IN THE DIGITAL AGE

SURVEY CONCEPT & ANALYSIS BY VERTICAL-LIFE

To understand how digitalization is transforming the climbing gym experience, we surveyed both climbers and gym operators.

The results highlight how tools like self-check-in, 24/7 access, and digital membership management are influencing daily routines, operations, and expectations. While climbers shared how they use and value digital services, gym owners provided insights into staffing, access systems, and new business models.

Together, their perspectives reveal where the indoor climbing industry stands today – and where it's heading next.

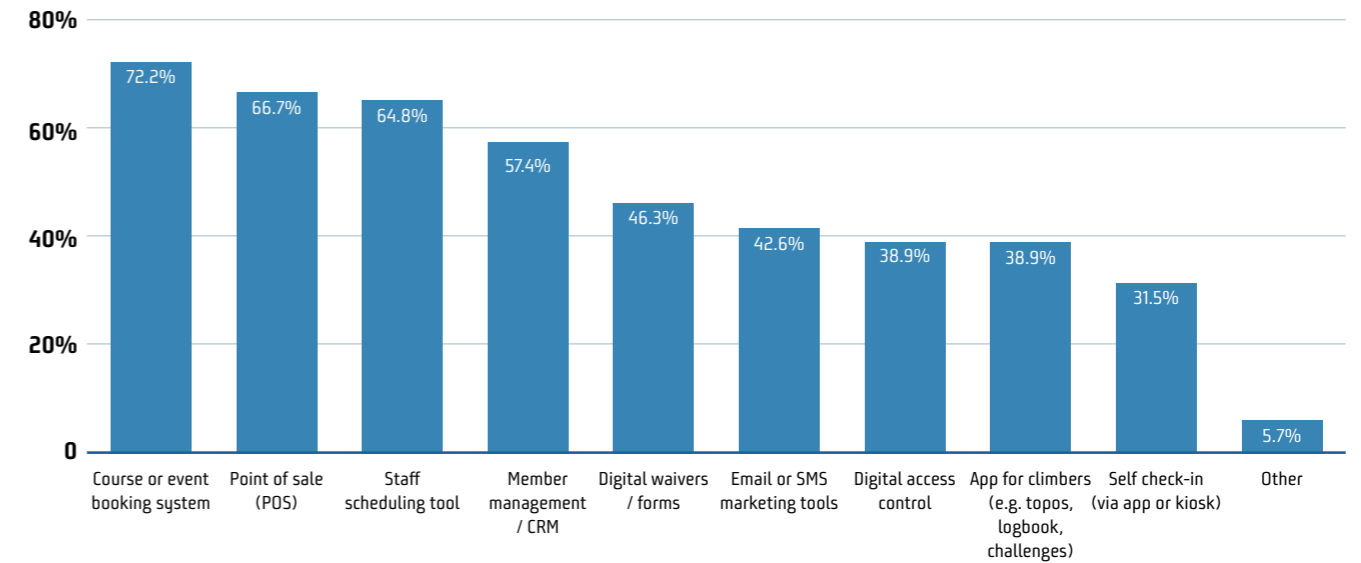


GYM MANAGER SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

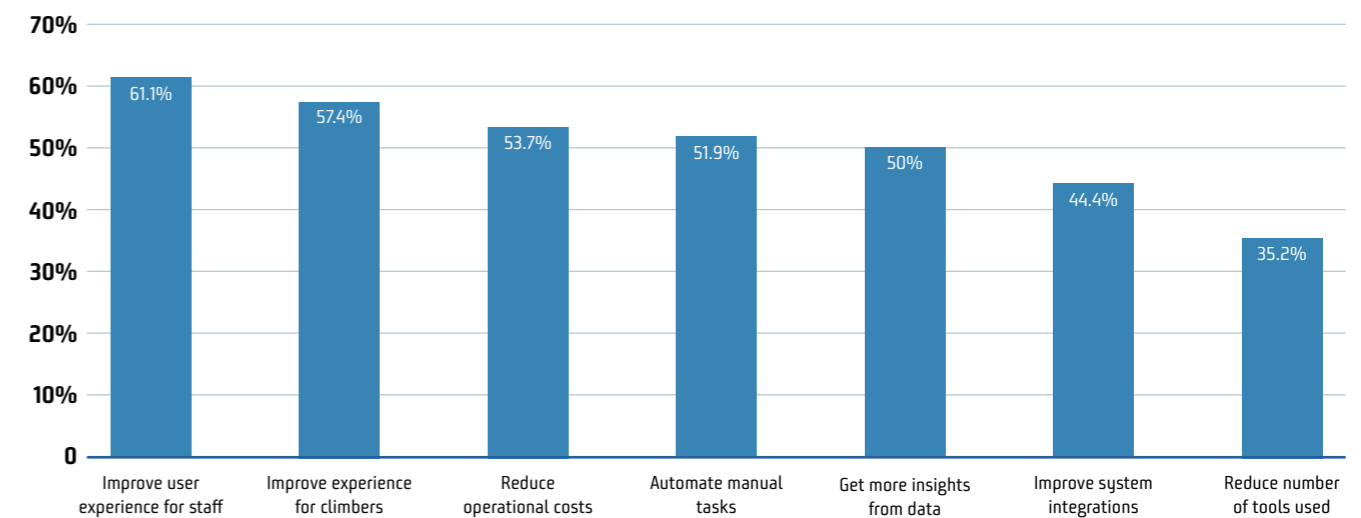
The following results are based on a B2B survey conducted in 2025 with 54 climbing gym operators. The survey focuses on digital access systems, check-ins, staffing, and how gyms are adapting to new business models such as staff-free entrances and 24/7 opening. The findings reveal how operators view digitalization and its potential to improve efficiency, safety, and the overall customer experience.

The typical climbing gym is **located in a city (66.7%)**, usually operates as a **single facility (74.1%)**, and most often offers **bouldering and lead climbing (38.9%)** on a total area of **1,000–2,000 m² (38.9%)**. On average, it records **100–300 visitors per day (48.1%)**, is **open seven days a week (74.1%)**, and employs **more than 15 staff members**.

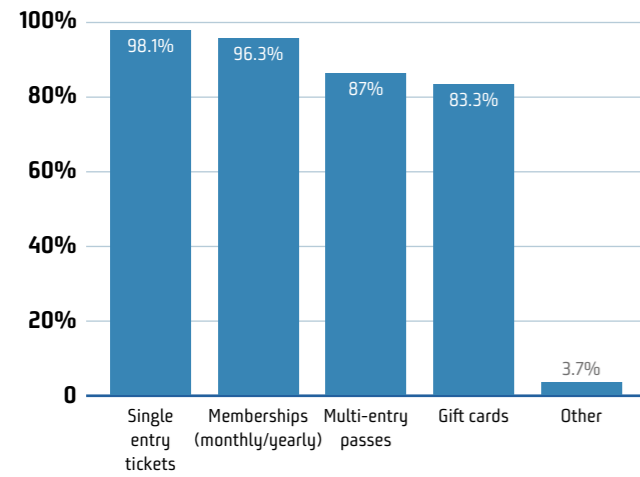

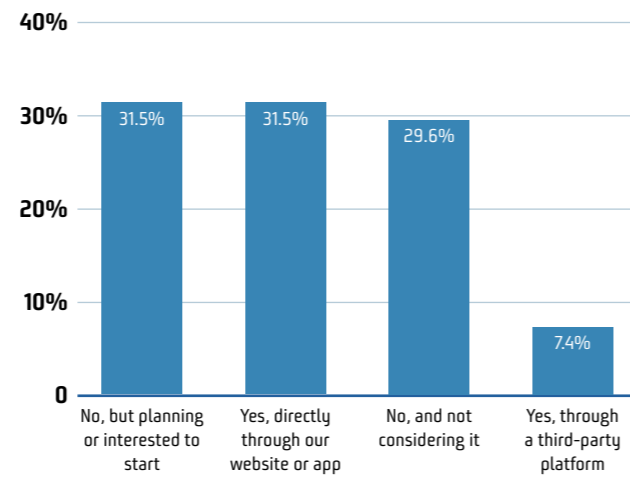

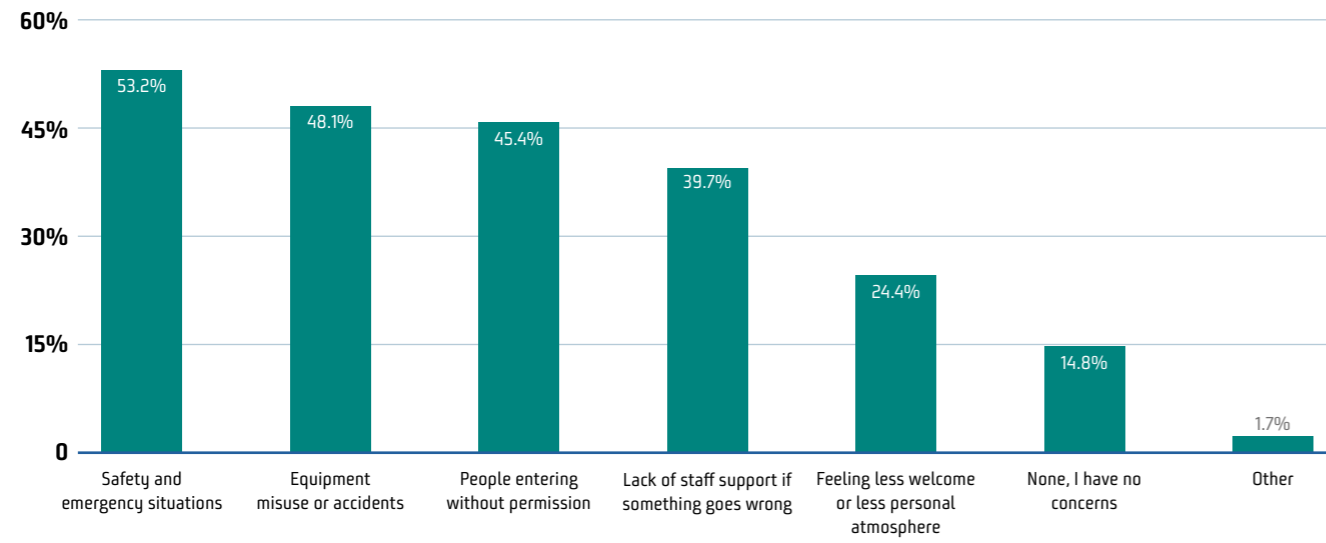


CUSTOMER SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

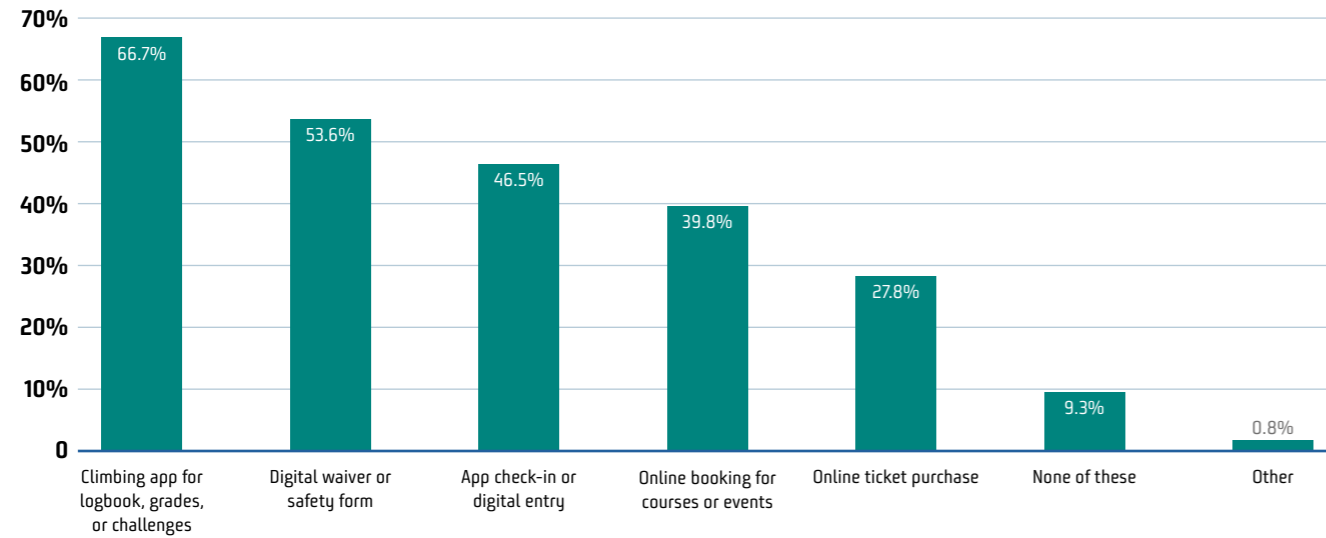
The following results are based on a B2C survey conducted in 2025 with 669 participants. The survey explores how climbers use digital tools in their gym experience — from self-check-in and 24/7 access to managing memberships and tickets. Their responses provide valuable insights into what today's climbers truly need and expect from modern climbing gyms.

The average climber is **30–40 years old (33.7%)**, climbs **two to three times per week (52.3%)**, and mainly visits **mixed gyms offering both bouldering and rope climbing (54.6%)**. Over **60%** have a **monthly or yearly membership**, and more than half (**52.8%**) occasionally visit other gyms.

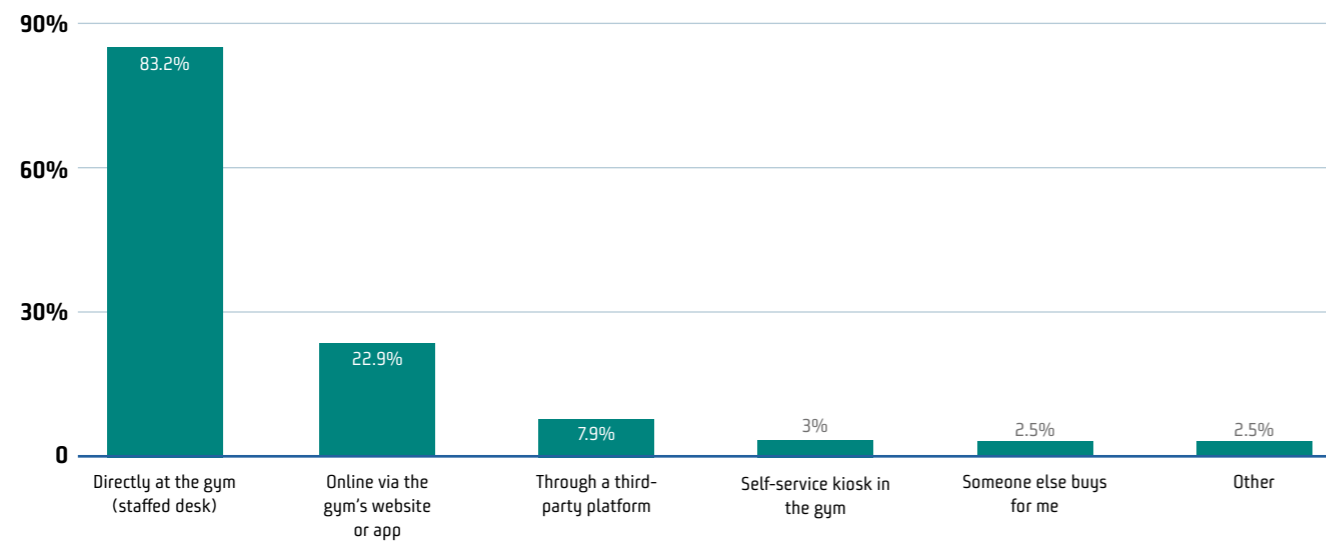

Fifteen years ago, the climbing industry worldwide had a different landscape. Gyms were starting to pop up like mushrooms in cities around the globe, and climbing was slowly transitioning from a fringe sport into a mainstream activity.

Moreover, the idea of paying a freelancer for a service that had been done in-house for free or at a minimal cost seemed unnecessary to



many owners. We often had to educate clients on the value of professional routesetting, explaining how a well-designed route could enhance climber satisfaction, reduce injury risks and boost customer retention. We began by offering consultations to demonstrate the impact of professional setting. Slowly but surely climbers started to notice differences between the routes, we often heard our routes were engaging, diverse and thoughtfully set, catering to a wider range of skill levels and climbing styles. As more climbers voiced their appreciation, gym owners began to see the benefits of investing in high-quality routesetting.

After a few years, we had the opportunity to diversify the business and we launched workshops and training programs



for new and aspiring routesettlers, sharing our knowledge and expertise. 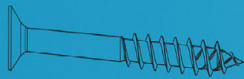

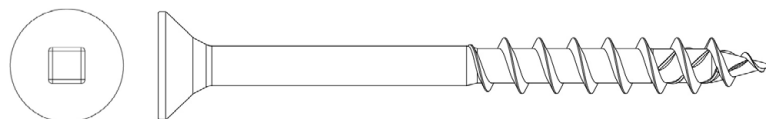
